Delivery of an SESNZ recognised workshop/ seminar.	1 point per learning hour	SESNZ certificate of presentation.
Full delivery of tertiary subject/ unit/course (Tutors/Lecturers only).	15 points for first unit of learning and 10 points for subsequent deliveries.	Letter from employer listing course name/topic, learning hours.
Guest lecturer at tertiary studies.	3 points per lecture (first delivery) 2 points per lecture (subsequent deliveries)	Copy of the course outline identifying you as lecturer
Delivering other courses within the scope of practice	1 point per lecture	Copy of the course flyer identifying you as presenter.
Delivering relevant services in the workplace within your professional scope of practice.	3 points per in-service (first delivery) 2 points per in-service (subsequent deliveries).	Letter from employer listing course name/topic, learning hours and date of presentation.
Publishing in a relevant peer reviewed journal.	10 points if primary author 5 points if other (In year of publication only)	Copy of the front page of journal and copy of abstract/article, listing authors & publication information including date of publication.
Publishing in a relevant non-peer reviewed media e.g. newsletter, newspaper	3 points if primary author (In year of publication only).	Copy of the front page of media and copy of abstract/article, listing authors & publication information including date of publication.
Publishing a textbook within your profession scope of practice.	10 points if primary author 5 points if other (In year of publication only).	Copy of the front page of textbook listing authors, contents page & publication information including date of publication.
Podium or poster presentation at a conference relevant to the industry (within your profession scope of practice).	5 points if primary author	Copy of the front page of program/ proceedings and copy of abstract, listing authors.
Submission for relevant funding/grants/pilot programs.	10 points if primary author and 5 points if other.	Copy of the front page of report listing authors.
Peer review of a professionally relevant journal article.	2 points	Letter from editor outlining your involvement.
Editor of a relevant journal.	10 points per year	Copy of journal, listing you as editor.

Category 3: Self-education



Rview of research publication, journal articles, editorials, and text books

Activity	Points claimable	Evidence required
Reading of a relevant scientific article or chapter from a professional publication, that is within your profession scope of practice.	1 point per article	A copy of the first page or abstract showing the title and authors, with the following statement "I (first name, last name) acknowledge that I have read this professional resource in its entirety for educational purposes" with date.
Listening to a relevant scientific podcast or similar recording from a professional body or education supplier, that is within your profession scope of practice, where an assessment or certificate is not provided.	1 point per article	A copy of the title page of the recording or a tax invoice, showing the title and authors, with the following statement "I (first name, last name) acknowledge that I have read this professional resource in its entirety for educational purposes" with date.

Category 4: Community-Service



Student supervision, position on SESNZ committee/chapters/board, and promotion of the industry to the community

Activity	Points claimable	Evidence required
40 – 100 hours face to face student supervision (based on number of hours you spend supervising, regardless of student numbers/hours).	4 points	
101 – 200 hours face to face student supervision (based on number of hours you spend supervising).	6 points	A letter from the graduate or tertiary organisation documenting the hours and nature of supervision.
201 – 300 hours face to face student supervision (based on number of hours you spend supervising.	8 points	
Chairperson or board member of SESNZ	10 points	A copy of the meeting minutes stating your position

Category 4: Community-Service



Student supervision, position on SESNZ committee/chapters/board, and promotion of the industry to the community

Activity	Points claimable	Evidence required
A member of a non SESNZ S n C committee related to exercise and/or sports science (e.g. government, community organisation).	5 points per committee	A copy of the meeting minutes
Attendance at SESNZ National Annual General Meeting.	2 points	stating your position.
Attendance at special interest group meetings related to S n C.	1 point per meeting	
Relevant promotional activities (e.g. promoting SESNZ S n C at a conference, community or related event. Health Network)	2 points per activity	A letter from the conference/event organiser stating your involvement.
